FLOORING—UNDERGROUND CAR PARKING

Of particular interest to many of you would be our commercial flooring capabilities.

the surface at 8am Monday. This included cleaning the existing floor on the Friday night with product

QUEEN ELIZABETH HOSPITAL—500, 000 LTR WATER CATCHMENT TANK

With water conservation at the top of everyone's hit list today, the opportunity to participate in the development of 500, 000 litre stormwater catchment tank at Queen Elizabeth Hospital was too good an opportunity to turn down.

Whilst the initial specification offered several challenges due to severe cracking, we were able to develop a membrane system offering a 10yr

guarantee that should be operational well after its 10th birthday.

Although product application was tricky due to tank design, again we were able to complete the works on time & with minimal disruption the construction site.
